1. WHAT WAS THE LEAST AMOUNT OF TIME IT TOOK TO MAKE THE VOYAGE TO AMERICA? WHAT WAS THE MOST?
2. WHAT DID MITTELBERGER BLAME FOR THE SICKNESS AND DISEASE ABOARD SHIP?
3. UPON ARRIVAL IN PHILADELPHIA, WHY WERE SOME PASSENGERS REQUIRED TO STAY ON BOARD FOR TWO OR THREE WEEKS? WHAT DID MITTELBERGER THINK OF THIS PRACTICE?
4. DESCRIBE THE PROCESS OF INDENTURING. HOW WERE LABORERS CHOSEN? WHAT DETERMINED HOW LONG A PERSON SERVED?
5. AFTER READING THE ACCOUNT OF THE "SALE OF HUMAN BEINGS", HOW WAS THE PROCESS SIMILAR TO BEING SOLD INTO SLAVERY? WHAT SETS INDENTURED SERVANTS APART FROM SLAVES?
6. IF YOU WERE A YOUNG PERSON BETWEEN 10 AND 15 YEARS OF AGE, WHY DID YOU GET THE WORST DEAL AS AN INDENTURED SERVANT?
7. IN WHAT WAY WAS A YOUNG PERSON AT THE MERCY OF HIS OR HER PARENTS?
8. WHAT HAPPENED TO THE SPOUSE OF A HUSBAND OR WIFE WHO DIED ON BOARD AFTER MORE THAN HALF A TRIP WAS COMPLETED?
9. HOW DID MITTELBERGER FEEL ABOUT "NEWLANDERS"? WHAT WAS A "NEWLANDER"?
10. ACCORDING TO MITTELBERGER, WHAT HAPPENED TO YOUNG PEOPLE WHO SERVED FOR MANY YEARS AS INDENTURED SERVANTS WITH FREE-THINKERS AND INFIDELS?
11. NAME TWO LIBERTIES CITIZENS OF PENNSYLVANIA HAD COMPARED TO RESIDENTS OF OTHER COLONIES.

12. WHICH TWO RELIGIOUS GROUPS HAD THE MOST MEMBERS IN PENNSYLVANIA?

13. HOW DID INDIANS SUPPORT THEMSELVES IN PENNSYLVANIA?

14. HOW DID “ALL” PEOPLE TRAVEL TO CHURCH IN PENNSYLVANIA?

15. TO MITTELBERGER, WHY WAS IT HARD TO DISTINGUISH INDIAN MEN FROM INDIAN WOMEN?

16. WHY DID INDIANS LAUGH AT AMERICAN BUILDINGS WHEN VISITING PHILADELPHIA?

17. OBVIOUSLY, MITTELBERGER HAD CONFLICTING OPINIONS ABOUT INDIANS (SAVAGES). NAME TWO POSITIVE AND TWO NEGATIVE EXAMPLES HE GAVE IN THE ARTICLE.
