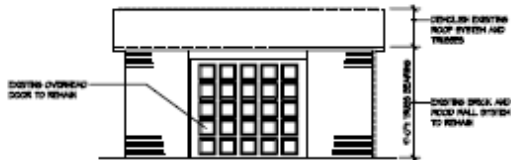

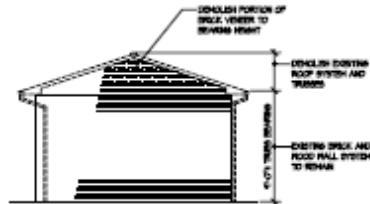

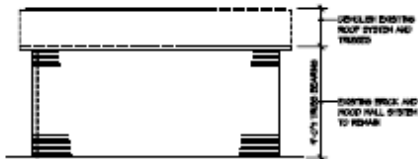

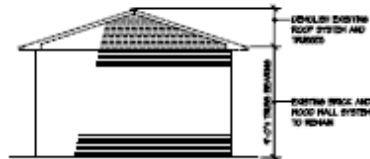
C BUILDING ELEVATION - RIGHT

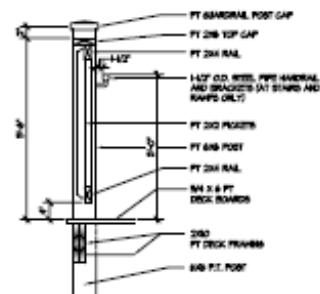
A STAIR ELEVATION

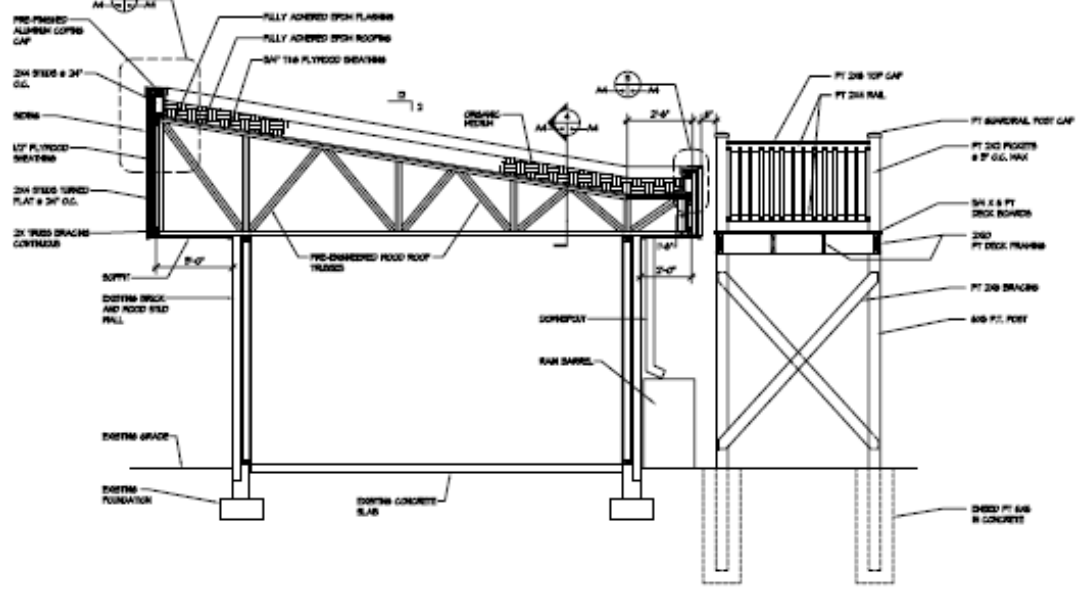


C STAIR SECTION

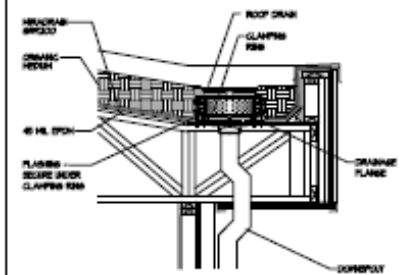

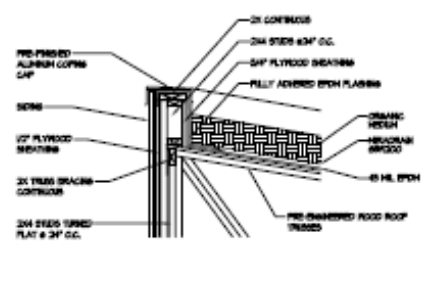

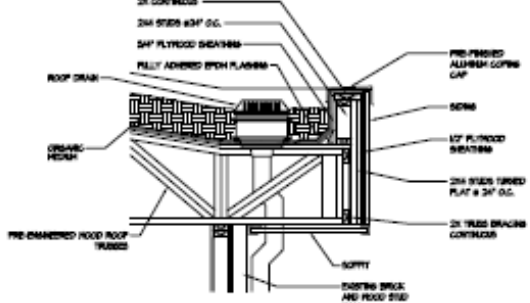

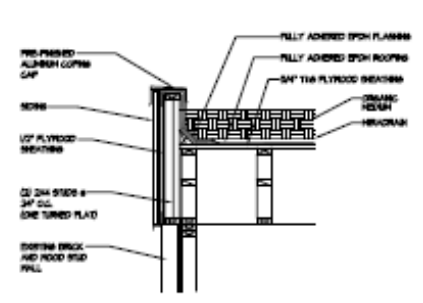
A DRAINAGE SECTION

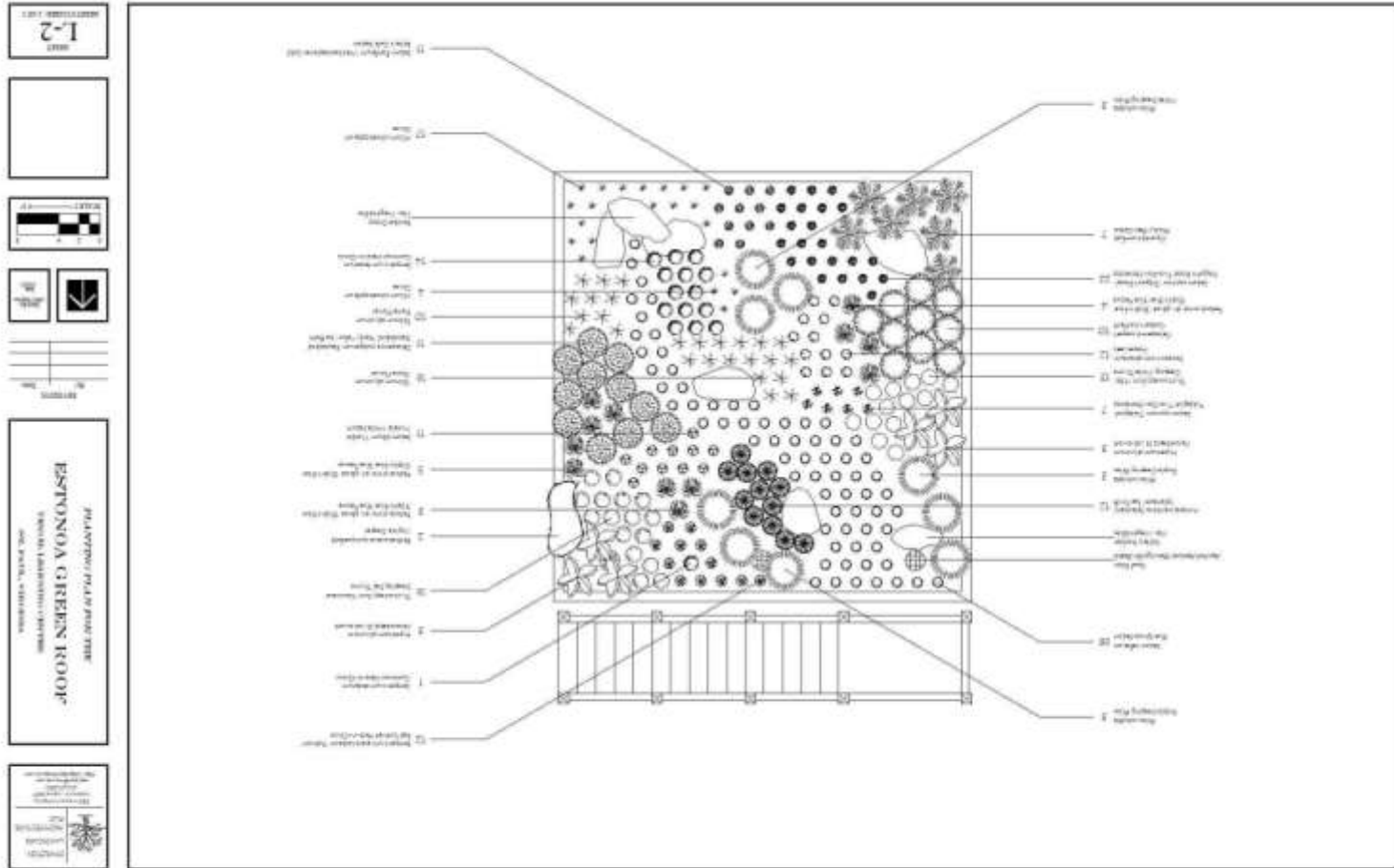

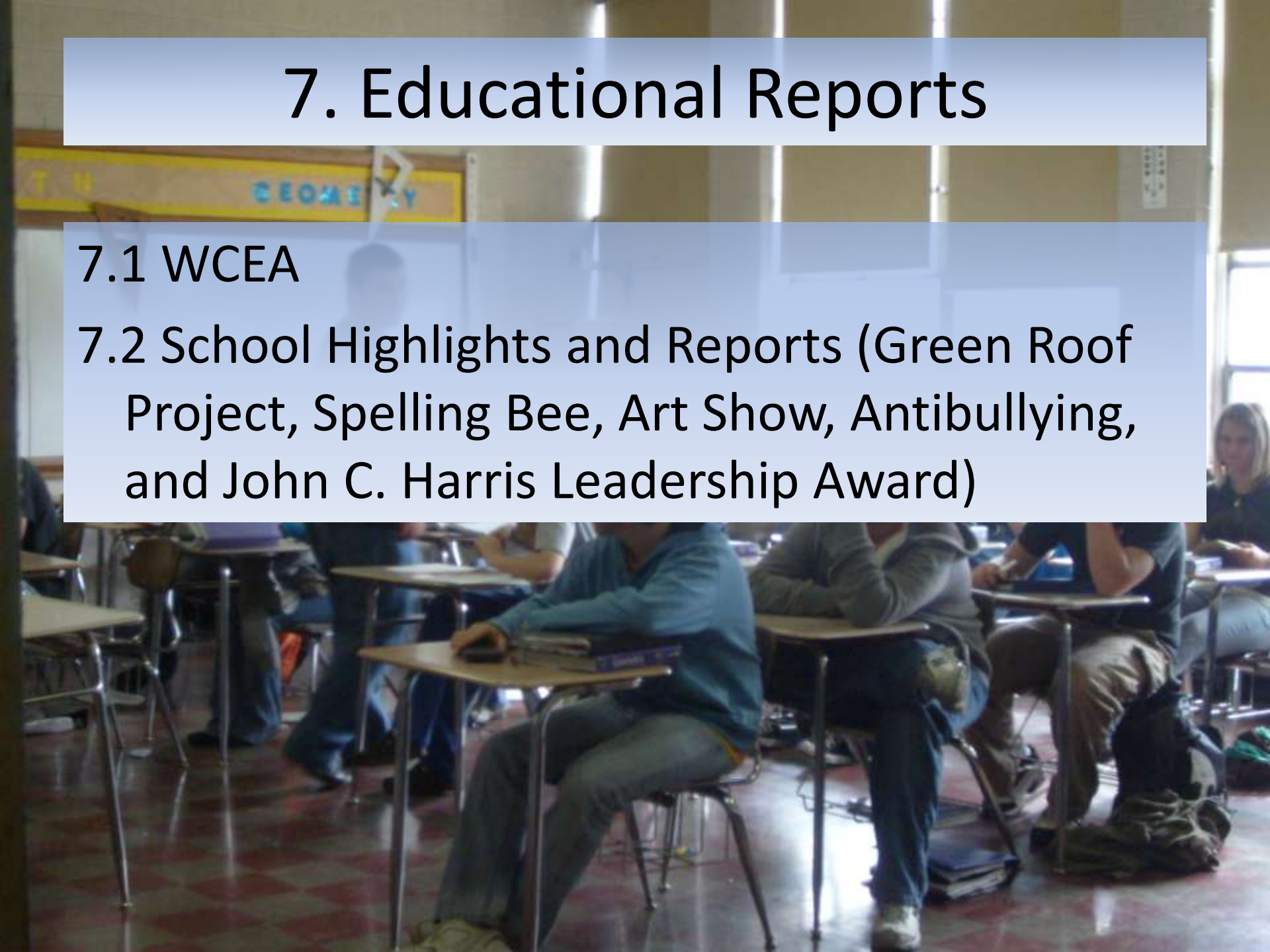

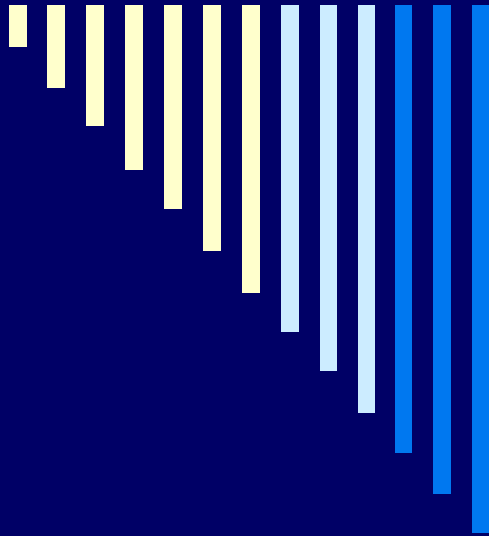

Request for Proposal – Actuarial Services

- ❑ Implementation of Government Accounting Standards Board Statement 45.
 - ❑ GASB 45 addresses the need to financially report Postemployment Benefits Other Than Pensions (OPEB).
 - ❑ GASB 45 requires local government employers to account and report the annual cost and outstanding obligations related to OPEB as they do for pensions.

Request for Proposal – Actuarial Services

- ❑ Most common OPEB activity is for post employment healthcare benefits.
 - ❑ Direct Benefit – employer pays for premium on behalf of the employee.
 - ❑ Indirect Benefit – allowing retirees to remain in active health insurance group. Sometimes referred to as a “blended” rate.

Request for Proposal – Actuarial Services

- Request that both the County of Wise, Virginia and Wise County Public Schools jointly seek actuarial services.
 - Financial savings in sharing of common expenses.
 - Separate reports for each entity.

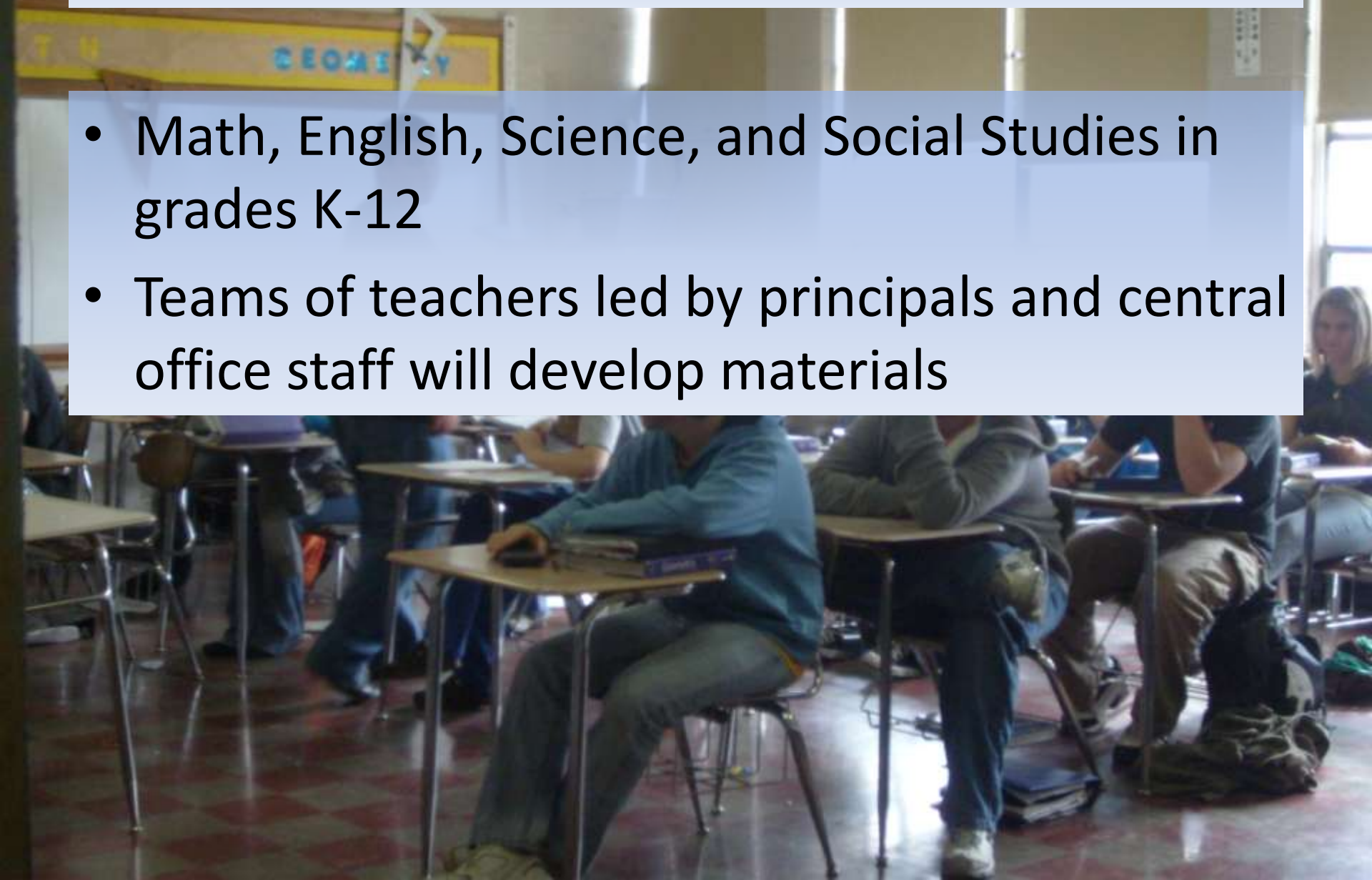

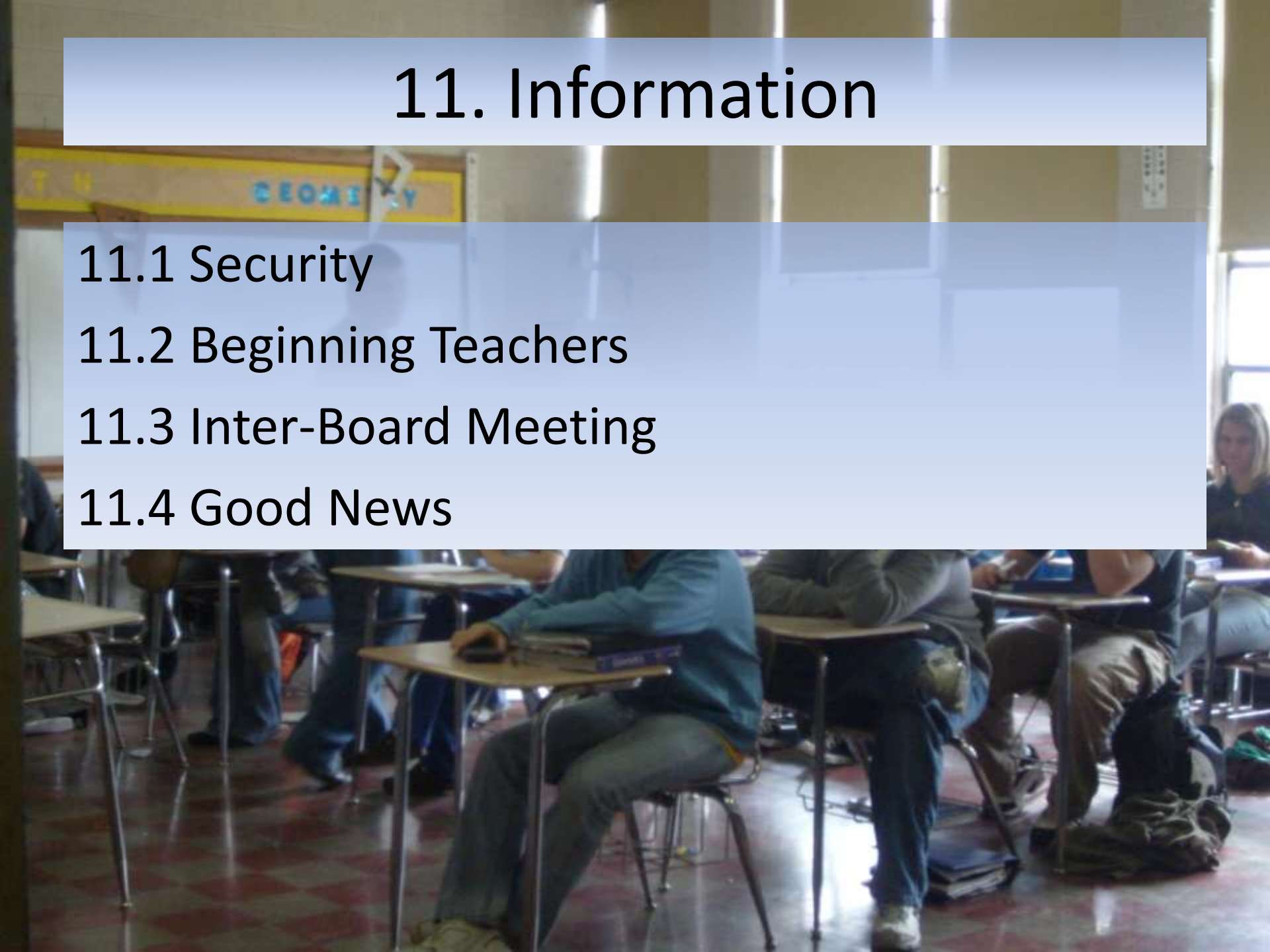

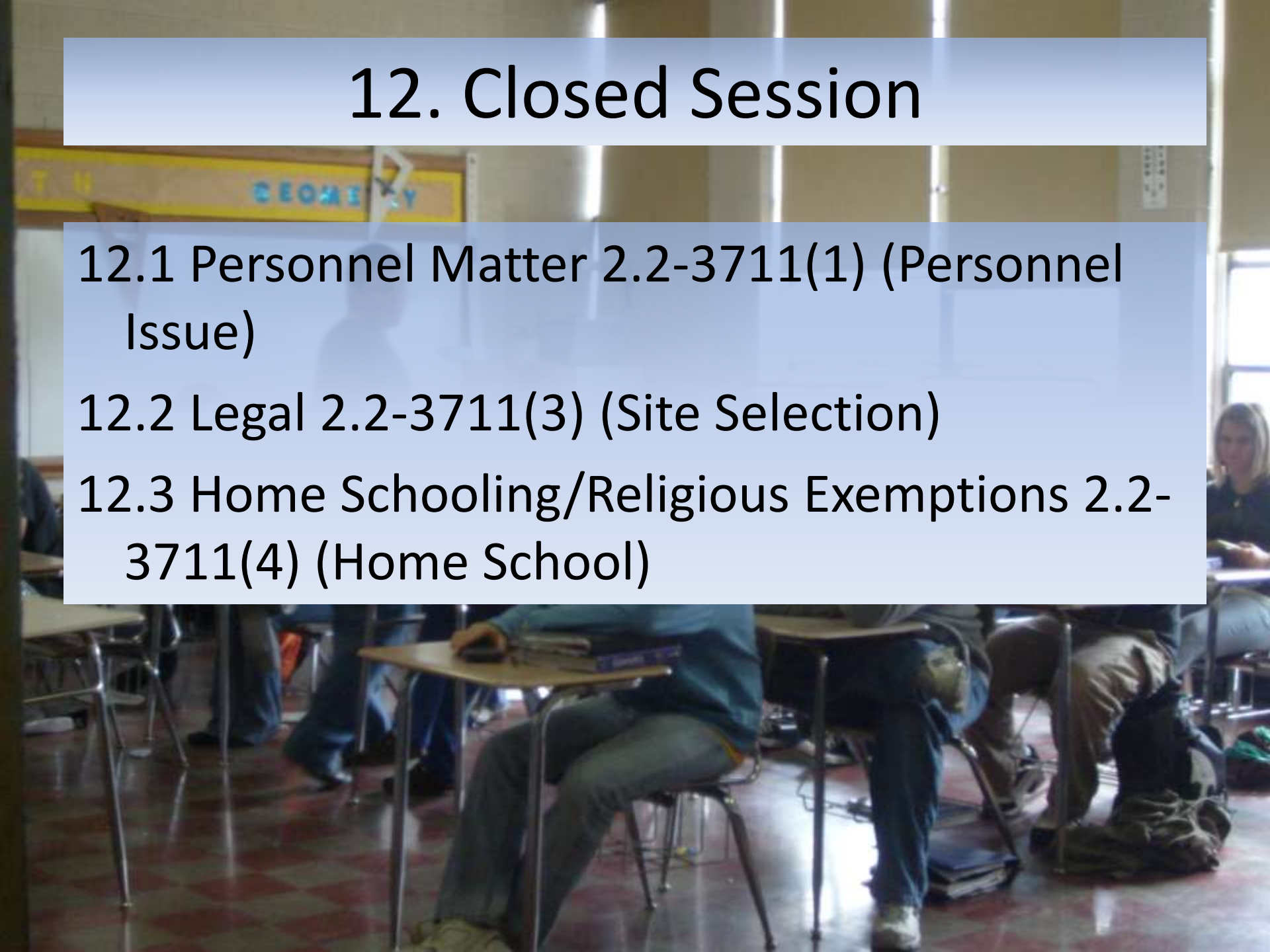
